- ✓ Be a producer member (or have at least one parent, grandparent, or legal guardian who is a producer member) in good standing of The Montana Grain Growers Association.
- ✓ Be enrolled as a full time student.
- ✓ Be pursuing an agricultural related degree.
- ✓ Provide a current official transcript.
- ✓ Complete the enclosed application.
- ✓ Provide two (2) nonfamily letters of reference.

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Scholastic Achievement
- o School Involvement
- o Community Involvement
- o Essay
